**2008 SEASON REVIEW**

---

The 2008 campaign ended with a 30-7 loss against Samford at Finley Stadium on Nov. 22, 2008. The loss dropped the Mocs to 1-11 on the season and marked the end of the Rodney Allison era of Chattanooga Football.

Allison coached UTC from 2003 until last season. He posted a 17-51 mark during his six years at Chattanooga. The Mocs were 6-5 in 2005, one of only two winning seasons for UTC since 1992.

**Seven Starting Seniors Finish Their Careers**

The Chattanooga Mocs had seven seniors in the starting lineup last season. Nose tackle Rodney Beamon and corner back Raeshon Ball were two-year letterwinners while defensive end Neil Brown was a three-year member of the Mocs. Linebacker Jarvis Newsome, fullback Brent Hayes, tight end Joseph Pitman and guard William Giles were all four-year players for UTC. All seven played in all 12 games last year while they combined for 79 starts.

**Mocs Needed a 100-yard Rusher**

Chattanooga went through the 2008 season without having a 100-yard rusher in a single game. Junior Erroll Wynn had the team's season-high when he rushed for 95 yards against Western Carolina. The last time UTC had a 100-yard rusher was the 2007 season finale against Appalachian State on Nov. 17 when Brian Fitzgerald (134) and Erroll Wynn (115) both capped the century mark.

**Fitzgerald Out Early**

Senior Bryan Fitzgerald was expected to carry much of the load in the Mocs' ground attack. He was coming off a junior campaign where he rushed for 798 yards and was a first-team preseason All-SoCon selection. His season was over before it started thanks to a preseason knee injury that kept him out for the entire 2008 campaign.

**Ground Game Lowest in 35 Years**

UTC totaled 919 yards on the ground last season. It was the fewest yards gained on the ground by a Mocs' squad since the 1973 team totalled 878. Their 76.6 yards-per-game average in 2008 was the lowest in the record books that date back to the 1963 season.

**Mocs Had a Tough Time Scoring in 2008**

Chattanooga put up just 153 points on the scoreboard in the 2008 season. Although they were never shutout, UTC's scored the fewest points since totalling 140 in 1984.

**Block Party**

In nine of the Mocs' 12 games there was a block either for or against Chattanooga...be it a punt, field goal or PAT.

**Ball Ends a Solid Two-Year Run**

After transferring from Central Michigan prior to the 2006 season, Raeshon Ball went on to total 93 tackles in 23 games at UTC. He also picked off three passes in his career. Ball was one of the primary kick-returns last season. while starting all

12 games at the cornerback position.

**Hazard Ends His Career a Year Early**

Junior WR/KR Jordan Hazard decided the 2008 season was his last, despite a strong output for the Mocs. He was second in all-time season kickoff return yards with 792. Only Michael Gilmore's (2004-06) 1,009 in 2004 was more by a Moc. He finishes No. 8 on the career list with 1,083 yards. His 43 kick returns in 2008 were just three short of the school record of 46 set in 2004 by Gilmore. Hazard's 68 career kick returns rank third on UTC's all-time list. He also managed two long touchdown catches last season, hauling in a 62-yarder against Cumberland and a 76 -yard pass against Georgia Southern.

**Brown Leads D**

Senior defensive end Neil Brown finished the season with 52 tackles, good for fifth on the team. After starting all 12 games, he also had seven tackles for a loss and 2.5 sacks. Brown actually graduated from UTC in the Spring of 2008 and was in graduate school for his final year of eligibility.

**Giles Graduates Early, Leads the Offensive Line**

Fifth-year senior William Giles graduated with a degree in Criminal Justice in May of 2008. He started 11 of 12 games at guard in his fifth year at UTC.

**Two on the Academic All-SoCon Team**

Senior William Giles and junior Steven Smigelsky both earned a spot on the Southern Conference All-Academic team. Honorees must have a 3.2 grade-point-average and compete in at least 50% of their teams' contests.

**Beamon Leads the Team in Sacks**

Senior defensive tackle Rodney Beamon started all 12 games last season for the Mocs. He managed 38 tackles, eight for a loss. He also recorded a team-high four sacks on the season.

**Lloyd Sets Punting Marks**

Junior Jeff Lloyd set UTC's single-game record when he kicked 13 punts in the season opener against Oklahoma.

**UTC Hosts Division I Championship Game**

UTC and the City of Chattanooga hosted the 2008 NCAA Division I Football Championship Game between the Richmond Spiders and the Montana Grizzlies on Dec. 19. Richmond won the game 24-7 in front of 17,823 fans. The game was televised on ESPN2. It was the 12th year UTC and Chattanooga had hosted the FCS Championship game.

Four days later, the Spiders' defensive coordinator Russ Huesman was introduced at Finley Stadium as the Mocs' 22nd head coach.

## No. 4 Oklahoma 57, Chattanooga 2

Aug. 30 • Memorial Stadium

NORMAN, Okla. --- Oklahoma scored on every first-half possession and made few mistakes en route to 50-0 halftime lead and the runaway victory, defeating Chattanooga 57-2.

Oklahoma RB Chris Brown scored the first of his three touchdowns on a six-yard run at 10:42 of the first quarter, and fellow back DeMarco Murray tallied his first of two TD runs on the ensuing Sooner possession with a one-yard run at 7:42.

Highly-touted QB Sam Bradford, who was 14-of-17 passing for 151 yards in the first half, hit Quentin Chaney on a three-yard TD pass, and a missed extra-point kick left the score at 20-0 with 3:55 left in the first quarter.

The second quarter started inauspiciously for the Mocs as a snap from center on a punt attempt sailed over punter Jeff Lloyd's head and out of the end zone for a safety at 13:33 of the second period.

Chattanooga settled down in the third quarter following a lightning delay that lasted over an hour. The Mocs (0-1) got on the scoreboard at 13:15 of the third quarter when the snap on an Oklahoma punt formation sailed over punter Mike Knall's head for a safety and two points. The Sooners made it 57-2 with 1:52 left in the quarter, capping an 11-play, 56-yard scoring drive with a one-yard Brown run. Neither team scored in the fourth quarter.

Starter Jare Gault did not complete a pass in eight attempts, although one completion was ruled a lateral by official statisticians. Junior Tony Pastore was 3-for-8 for 20 yards, and freshman Sloan Allison was 0-for-1.

JC transfer Shaun Kermah led UTC rushers with 37 yards on 17 carries. Junior Erroll Wynn had eight total rushing yards on 10 carries before a hand injury took him out of the game.

A 1:12 severe storm and lightning delay at halftime kept the teams in the locker room and sent fans scurrying for cover under the stands. The delay began at 7:54 p.m. CT, and the game resumed at 9:10 p.m. Many of the 84,715 fans in attendance did not return following the storm.

## Chattanooga 47, Cumberland 6

Sept. 6 • Finley Stadium

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn.---The Chattanooga Mocs (1-1) overcame a sloppy first half to pull away to a 47-6 win over Cumberland (1-1) in the Mocs' home opener. Chattanooga used a dynamic passing attack gaining 368 yards in the air while posting 503 yards of total offense.

The first half saw the Mocs move the ball well, but not find the end zone consistently. The first six UTC drives went deep into CU territory, but resulted in just 16 points due to turning the ball over on downs once, two missed field goals and a missed PAT.

Junior QB Tony Pastore came off the bench to post career-high numbers with 320 yards on 15 of 27 passing. He tossed three touchdowns to go with one interception. Starting QB Jare Gault was five-of-nine for 48 yards.

The favorite targets of the night were Blue Cooper and Clint Woods who combined for 18 of the 20 receptions for 334 yards. Cooper had 10 catches for 159 yards (career high) and two TDs, while Woods had a career-high 175 yards on eight receptions and one score.

The Mocs' passing attack was very good on long-range throws with seven completions of 20 yards or more. The QBs combined to complete 20 of 36 passes with three TDs and one interception. The pick came when a Chattanooga receiver slipped during his route.

Erroll Wynn, slowed by a fractured wrist, carried the ball a team-high 18 times for 57 yards, while Shaun Kermah totaled 77 yards on 12 rushes including a 24-yard touchdown run to cap the scoring for the night.

The defense held the Bulldogs to 283 yards on the night. CU was limited to just 143 passing yards on 16 of 37 passing with three interceptions and a touchdown. The rushing attack gained 3.7 yards per carry (38-140). The Mocs were paced by LB Joseph Thornton's nine stops. Safety Tony Swafford made five tackles to go with an interception and a blocked kick.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.---The Chattanooga Mocs (1-2) dropped a 46-7 decision at Florida State (2-0) in front of an announced crowd of 71,596. Despite battling for 60 minutes, the Mocs could not match the Seminoles in the long run.

FSU scored on its first two possessions opening the scoring on a 44-yard from Christian Ponder to Corey Surrency with 8:33 left to play. With a 14-0 deficit, the Mocs responded with a quick strike three-play, 60-yard scoring drive in just one minute as Tony Pastore withstood a wicked shot as he released a perfect 62-yard toss down the right sideline to Jordan Hazard.

Florida State answered even quicker with a 23-second, two play drive as Ponder and Surrency hooked up again this time from 39 yards. The Mocs held the Seminoles on their fourth possession as FSU drove 67 yards only to miss a 44-yard Zach Hobby field goal attempt. A Hobby field goal (43 yards) at the halftime horn game the 'Noles a 30-7 halftime advantage.

Chattanooga was held to 164 yards of total offense with 135 coming in the air. Tony Pastore (5-8-0/106 yds) and Jare Gault (5-7-0/29 yds) combined to complete 10 of 15 passes, 66.7 percent, with one TD and zero interceptions.

Shaun Kermah led the rushing attack with 29 yards on seven carries. Chris Pitchford's three receptions led the receivers with Hazard coming in with two catches for 66 yards and the score. Hazard had 174 all-purpose yards on the day.

Christian Ponder led the 'Noles with 180 yards in the air as three quarterbacks played for FSU amassing 297 passing yards with four TDs. Antone Smith led all rushers with 78 yards on 13 rushes. FSU had 494 yards of offense to Chattanooga's 164.

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn. – In its first game of the season against a FCS opponent, the Mocs fell to Jacksonville State 31-3 Saturday night at Finley Stadium.

Quarterback Jare Gault completed 10 of 18 passes for 64 yards, while gaining 28 yards on the ground. Erroll Wynn was the Mocs' leading runner with 48 yards on nine carries. Wide-out Clint Woods paced Mocs receivers with nine catches for 72 yards.

Leading the way for Jacksonville State was LSU transfer Ryan Perrilloux. The junior threw for 122 yards and a touchdown, and also ran for 31 yards and another score. The Gamecocks featured a two-headed running back tandem in Tremayne Cogger and Daniel Jackson, as both backs combined for 234 yards and one touchdown.

The Gamecocks broke the scoreless tie in the middle of the first quarter thanks to a 35-yard field goal from Gavin Hallford. Just over six minutes later, JSU would strike again, this time on a 35-yard run from Perrilloux to put the Gamecocks up 10-0.

In the second quarter, Jacksonville State continued to pour the offense on thanks to Perrilloux. The Gamecock quarterback would account for another score, seven minutes in, on a 17-yard pass to Maurice Dupree.

Chattanooga struggled to find consistency on offense in the first half as the Mocs were held to 72 yards total. Mocs quarterback Tony Pastore was held in check during the first half as the UTC signal caller was 3-8 for eight yards. Pastore also accounted for three interceptions in the first half as the Mocs' passing game was held to only 29 yards in the air.

In the second half, the Mocs were able to get on the scoreboard thanks to a third quarter 43-yard field goal from Craig Camay to make the score 24-3. The Mocs defense was able to slow down the potent Gamecock attack in the second half as well, holding Jacksonville State to 173 yards of total offense.

DE Neil Brown led the defense with nine tackles, eight solo and one for loss. LB Jarvis Newson added seven tackles with two coming for loss.

The Mocs were able to get back on the board in the fourth quarter on a 3-yard run from Erroll Wynn for the touchdown. Wynn's run finished an eight play, 66-yard drive to make the score 28-10.

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn.—On a bright, sunny autumn afternoon, No. 3 Elon (7-1/5-0) handed the Chattanooga Mocs (1-7/0-4) a 42-7 defeat at Finley Stadium.

After an Andrew Wilcox 37-yard field goal gave Elon a 3-0 lead, the Mocs answered with an impressive touchdown drive capped by a four-yard touchdown pass from Jare Gault to Clint Woods to give Chattanooga a 7-3 advantage at 14:45 in the second quarter. The touchdown drive was 13 plays for 79 yards in 7:48 and it marked the third straight game with a TD pass from Gault.

Wilcox followed with another field goal from 38 yards out to cut the lead to 7-6 (9:37). The Phoenix tacked on two touchdowns to take a 20-7 lead into the break as it scored on all three of its second quarter possessions. But the score did not go the way of the Mocs as the Catamounts (3-7/1-5) captured a 27-7 win over visiting Chattanooga (1-8/0-5). WCU was opportunistic with 21 points following Mocs miscues.

The Catamounts opened the scoring with a four-yard scoring toss from Zack Jaynes to Adam Hearn at 6:41 in the first quarter. The play came immediately after a Jeff Lloyd fumble on a botched snap during a punt attempt from the Mocs' own endzone.

Gault led the offense with 182 passing yards completing 11 of 17 attempts with two touchdowns. He averaged 16.5 yards per completion and his two touchdown tosses were from 40 and 31 yards out.
