## 2010 SEASON REVIEW

### SO, SO CLOSE

With playoff hopes still alive, the Mocs traveled to No. 7 Wofford for the season finale and UTC's biggest game in 26 years. Chattanooga needed a win to stay in the hunt for one of 10 at-large bids to the 20-team NCAA Football Championship Subdivision playoffs. UTC's only appearance in the FCS Playoffs came in 1984 when they tied for the Southern Conference Championship. Unfortunately, the Mocs came away with a 48-14 loss and finished just outside of the playoff picture.

The Mocs were just a few plays away from sitting at 9-2 on the season, having tied or led in the fourth quarter of three of their FCS losses on the year. UTC gave up double-digit fourth quarter leads against top-5 teams in each of their two losses. Against Appalachian State, Chattanooga led 34-14 with just over 14 minutes left to go in the game before the Mountaineers came storming back for the 42-41 win. On the road against Jacksonville State, UTC led 17-0 in the third quarter and 17-7 in the fourth, before the Gamecocks posted a 21-17 win. The Mocs erased a 21-point deficit to tie Elon at 35 in the fourth quarter, however, two turnovers led to 14 unanswered points in the 49-35 loss.

### TWO-STRAIGHT WINNING MARKS FOR THE FIRST IN NEARLY TWO DECADES

The Mocs have posted 6-5 records in each of the last two years. It is the first time Chattanooga has recorded back-to-back winning records since the 1990 (6-5) and 1991 (7-4) campaigns.

### BEST SOCON FINISH AND MOST LEAGUE WINS IN YEARS

Chattanooga finished tied for third with a 5-3 mark in the ultra-competitive Southern Conference. It is the best finish in the league since placing third in 1991 with a 4-3 mark. It is the most wins in SoCon action since going 5-2 in 1985.

### BRADFORD IS A 'SNEAKY-SNEAKY' ALL-AMERICAN

Ever since the early-season Mocs Media Luncheon when Head Coach Russ Huesman described Joel Bradford as - 'sneaky, sneaky' - the junior from Chattanooga has been asked about his deceptive speed and quickness after every big game. That question was posed a lot in 2010 since he twice set the school record for receiving yards in a game. He also had the two highest single-game totals in the NCAA this season. He first topped the UTC mark with 254 yards on 11 catches in a 42-24 win against Eastern Kentucky on Sept. 18. Bradford recorded his first career 100-yard game before the end of the first quarter, thanks in large part to an 80-yard touchdown connection with junior QB B.J. Coleman. That strike was the longest by a Moc since 1999 and just the eighth passing play of 80+ yards in school history. He received his first career SoCon Player of the Week honor following the ECU game.

Bradford bested his own mark with 274 yards in a 36-28 win at No. 25 Furman on Oct. 23. He was six yards shy of the SoCon mark set by Appalachian State's DaVon Fowlkes against Elon in 2004. He caught 15 passes, including one touchdown, in Chattanooga's win. Bradford was again named the SoCon Offensive Player of the Week after the Furman game. His 'sneakiest' game may have come against Samford when he posted 98 yards and touchdown on just three catches.

Bradford was named Associated Press Third Team All-American after breaking the Mocs' single-season school record with 1,284 receiving yards in 2010. His receiving total led the Southern Conference and was No. 2 in the nation this season. His 116.7 receiving yards-per-game ranked No. 3 in the country while his 7.4 receptions-per-game were No. 7 in the NCAA. He also added a team-high eight touchdown grabs to go along with his First Team All-SoCon honors.

### WISE NAMED SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Kadeem Wise (Lawrenceville, Ga.) swept the SoCon Freshman of the Year honors from both the coaches and the media. He is the second Moc to take both honors, joining running back James Roberts in 1989. Wise started all 11 games and finished with 29 tackles, six interceptions and six pass

break-ups. He picked off a personal-best two passes at Western Carolina on September 25. His six interceptions set a new UTC freshman record and tied for ninth in the nation, breaking the previous mark held by current head coach Russ Huesman. Huesman picked off five passes in his first season as a defensive back for the Mocs in 1978. Wise was also a second-team All-SoCon selection by the league's media.

### SCHOOL-RECORD NINE MOCS MAKE THE ALL-SOCON TEAM

The Mocs had nine different honorees between the All-SoCon coaches and media teams. That break the school record of eight UTC set last season. UTC also had eight following the 1979 season. The following Mocs were honored by the league's coaches, media or both:

### FIVE MOCS ON THE SOCON ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

Led by 2010 SoCon Freshman of the Year Kadeem Wise, the Mocs had a league-high five selections to the SoCon All-Freshman team. He was joined by receiver Marlon Anthony (Acworth, Ga.), running back Keon Williams (Chattanooga, Tenn.), defensive back D.J. Key (Centerville, Tenn.) and linebacker Gunner Miller (Chattanooga, Tenn.). Anthony had 17 catches for 195 yards and three touchdowns and Williams was second on the team with 500 rushing yards and four touchdowns. Key was second on the team with 57 tackles while Miller made five starts at linebacker.

### B.J. COLEMAN IS LIVING UP TO THE HYPE

Junior QB B.J. Coleman created quite a stir in the Scenic City when he announced his decision to transfer from Tennessee to Chattanooga in the summer of 2009. His teammates have showed confidence in him by naming him one of three team captains and the league's coaches pegged him a Second Team All-SoCon selection in 2010. He continued to impress in 2010 with:

- 33-58 for a career-high 432 yards passing and two TDs at Furman.
  - 5th most passing yards in a game in school history.
  - Most passing yards in the SoCon.
  - 3rd highest total in the NCAA this season.
- 215-382 (56.3%) for 2,994 yards, 26 TDs and 13 INTs on the year.
  - 2nd in the SoCon and 7th in the NCAA, with 272.4 passing yds/g.
  - 2,996 passing yards is No. 3 on the Mocs' single-season list
  - 26 TDs is No. 2 on the Mocs' single-season list...record is 27
- 5,344 passing yards in his career...5th all-time at UTC.
- 16 200-yard passing games is 2nd on the Mocs' career list.
- 43 career TDs is No. 2 on the Mocs' list.

### IN THE RANKINGS

UTC spent two weeks ranked in the FCS top-25 for the first time since 1997. Chattanooga climbed as high as No. 20 in the nation before falling to Elon on Oct. 30. UTC received 17 votes in the final Sports Network Top-25 and would be No. 37 if the rankings were expanded. Chattanooga's No. 20 ranking on Oct. 25 was their highest national ranking since reaching the No. 17 slot in the Sporting News Preseason Top-25 in 1992. Chattanooga is 3-11 all-time as a ranked team. The highest national ranking on record was No. 9 on Sept. 21, 1992.

### MOCS WITH THE SIXTH TOUGHEST SCHEDULE IN 2010

According to NCAA.com, the Mocs finished the 2010 season with the No. 6 toughest schedule in the Football Championship Subdivision. UTC faced five ranked FCS teams in 2010, including No. 3 Appalachian State, No. 5 Jacksonville State, No. 18 Georgia Southern, No. 25 Furman and No. 7

Wofford. Throw in a trip to Auburn when the eventual BCS champions were No. 2 in the nation and that is a tough slate for any squad to face. The five teams that beat the UTC in 2010 finished with a combined record of 48-14, including 12-0 Auburn.

**SPEEDY SUTHERLAND LED THE SOCON IN ALL-PURPOSE YARDS**

Sophomore WR Brian Sutherland (Smyrna, Ga.) was a solid contributor on offense throughout the season. He led the league with 165.7 all-purpose yards per game. At No. 2 Auburn he set career-highs with 10 receptions for 97 yards. He also ran back a kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown and set a new career mark with 254 all purpose yards in the game. The 98-yard KOR was the second longest in school history and earned him the SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week honor. In the season opener against Appalachian State he had 239 all-purpose yards, including 95 rushing, 85 receiving and 59 return yards. His total of 1,823 all purpose yards were made up of 180 rushing, 729 receiving and 914 on kick-off returns.

**A MIGHTY WYNN**

Senior RB Erroll Wynn saw his first action in nearly two years when he had 13 carries for 98 yards, all in the second half, at Jacksonville State. He sat out the 2009 season as a redshirt and was held out of the ASU game. He finished with a solid senior season, leading the team with 673 yards on 124 carries and five touchdowns. He was No. 5 in the SoCon with 65.3 rushing yards per game. Wynn's 584 career carries is 3rd all time at UTC and ranked 14th among all active players in the FCS. He is No. 4 on the Mocs' career list with 2,457 rushing yards. He had six career 100-yard games, including two in 2010. He ran for 125 yards and two touchdowns on 27 carries against Georgia Southern. He also put up 100 yards on 21 carries against Samford.

**VERES PRESSED INTO KICKING DUTIES MAKES A MARK ON THE BOOKS**

Chattanooga was expecting to replace senior All-American PK Craig Camay with true freshman Nick Pollard (Nashville, Tenn.). However, Pollard was out with an injury, forcing sophomore WR Jeff Veres (Thompson's Station, Tenn.) to return to his old position. Veres finished 39-42 on PATs this season. His 39 PATs are second on the Mocs single-season list, trailing only Joe Zeman's 43 in 1979.

**AWUAH SCORES BY THROWING, RUNNING, CATCHING & ON SPECIAL TEAMS**

Sophomore running back Chris Awuah (Marietta, Ga.) led the tem in rushing as a freshman with 459 yards in 2009. This season, a heated battle for the starting job pushed him down the depth chart, but his versatility kept him in the middle of the action. This season he threw for a score, caught a touchdown pass, ran for another one and scored on special teams. His TD pass came in the season opener vs. Appalachian State while his scoring catch came against Georgia Southern. He ran for a TD at Furman and scored on special teams after blocking a punt at Wofford.

**DONALD AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN SACKS**

Junior DE Chris Donald (Huntingdon, Tenn.) did not come with the same hype as fellow junior B.J. Coleman did when he followed Coleman from Tennessee to Chattanooga. Despite being the first 5-star prep player to come to UTC, Donald started slow in the spring. He moved from linebacker to defensive line and took off. He had a sack and forced a fumble against Appalachian State and then unloaded for 12 tackles at Jacksonville State. He added another 2.5 sacks against ECU and 1.5 at Furman. His 7.5 sacks on the year Tied for No. 24 in the nation and represent the third highest single-season total in school history.

**MOCS OFFENSE PUT UP IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS**

Chattanooga averaged 430 yards of total offense per game, ranking No. 11 in the nation and third in the SoCon. The Mocs' 277 passing yards per game were second in the league and No. 8 in the nation. UTC topped 500 yards of total offense four times this season - 548 vs. ECU, 568 at Furman, 504 vs. Elon and 550 vs. Samford...it is the most 500-yard games in a season since reaching that mark five times in 2000.

**CHATTANOOGA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS**

UTC finished in the top-25 in the FCS in six categories, including the following:

- No. 2 in 3rd Down Conversions - 50.0% (73/146)
- No. 11 in Total Offense - 430.0 yards per game.
- No. 18 (tie) in Fumbles Recovered - 14
- No. 8 in Passing Offense - 277.2 yards per game.
- No. 17 in Scoring Offense - 31.6 points per game.
- No. 23 in Passing Efficiency - 136.82

**NINE MOCS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-SOCON**

Chattanooga had nine football student-athletes, including eight starters, who were named to the Academic All-SoCon team. To be eligible, student-athletes must carry at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average entering the fall season and are required to compete in at least one-half of their team's competitions during the recently-concluded fall campaign. In addition, the student-athletes must have successfully completed at least 24 credit hours in the previous two semesters. Those on the team included sophomores Adam Miller, Jeff Veres and Shane Heatherly, juniors Brock Oliver, Joel Bradford, Mike Hammons, B.J. Coleman, Ryan Geist and Ryan Consiglio. The nine members on the team in one year is just shy of the school record 10 members UTC put on the 2009 squad.

**MOCS BREAK SINGLE-SEASON ATTENDANCE RECORD**

For the second year in a row, Chattanooga shattered the single-season attendance record at Finley Stadium. A total of 63,494 fans attended the five Mocs games in 2010, an average of 12,699 per game. The season record was set last year when 52,515 fans attended UTC's five home games and only four single-game crowds prior to the season top the 2010 average. Chattanooga almost doubled the its 34,489 total from the six-game schedule in 2008, the year before the arrival of current head coach Russ Huesman.

**MOCS BREAK SEASON TICKET SALES RECORD AGAIN IN 2010**

The Chattanooga Mocs broke the all-time season ticket mark at Finley Stadium on Wednesday, Sept. 1, 2010, topping the old mark of 2,527 set in 2009. UTC finished with 2,676 season tickets sold for the current campaign. This is the fourth year UTC has topped the 2000 plateau, including 2,003 in 1998 and 2,300 in 1997.

**UTC IS IN THE TOP-25 IN ATTENDANCE**

With four home crowds topping the 10,000 mark in 2010, the Mocs are in the top-25 in the nation in total home attendance. The Mocs total attendance of 63,494 is 21st in the country. UTC averaged 12,699 fans on average to Finley Stadium for its home games, ranking No. 24 in the FCS.

**HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE**

The increased attendance at Finley Stadium is creating a true home-field advantage for the Mocs. UTC is currently 7-3 at home in the Russ Huesman era. The Mocs were a paltry 24-40 in the 12 seasons at Finley Stadium prior to Huesman's arrival in 2009.
