# H. HINDIHLOOK EXCITEMENT CONTINUES TO GROW

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga football team is gearing up for another exciting season this fall. The Mocs are anxious to get back on the field after a tough campaign in 2011. UTC went 5-6 overall, with five of its losses coming by a combined 12 points.

After going 6-5 in each of head coach Russ Huesman's first two seasons, UTC came into 2011 with high expectations and a national ranking. However, the Mocs missed out on their first playoff appearance since 1984 thanks to three 28-27 defeats. UTC was competitive in every game, but could not get the game-clinching score or all-important first down late in the game.

The 2012 team will also have high hopes and a preseason ranking when action begins in September. Despite last year's struggles. UTC was picked to finish fourth in the SoCon by both the league's media and coaches in 2012. It is the first time Chattanooga has been picked that high in both polls since the 1991 season.

The excitement is centered around the fact that the Mocs return eight starters to what was the top defense in the Southern Conference last season. UTC is led by a pair of preseason All-Americans in senior defensive end Josh Williams and junior linebacker Wes Dothard.

Williams is the all-time sack leader at UTC with 21.5 in his career, while Dothard was a first team All-American in 2011. Junior defensive back D.J. Key returns and is a preseason first team All-SoCon selection. Junior defensive back Kadeem Wise and sophomore defensive end Davis Tull made the preseason Also gone from last year is All-American All-SoCon second team.

The Mocs finished the year leading the SoCon in total defense (305.3), scoring defense (19.7 ppg) and turnover margin (+9). Chattanooga was also No. 2 in the

nation in pass defense (140.6) in 2011.

Gone from the offense is quarterback B.J. Coleman, who was taken in the seventh round of the NFL Draft by the Green Bay Packers in April. Despite losing an NFL signal caller, the Mocs are very excited about their returners and newcomers under center.

Terrell Robinson stepped in for an injured Coleman midway through the year and had an excellent season. He was named the SoCon Freshman of the Year and is fighting for the starting job in 2012. He will be pushed by junior Graham Nichols and freshman Jacob Huesman.

receiver Joel Bradford. Bradford started every game over the last two seasons and has some big numbers to fill. Junior Marlon Anthony is ready to step out of Bradford's shadow and carry the load among the receivers.

Chattanooga returns four of five starters on the offensive line, including preseason All-SoCon pick and senior captain Adam Miller. Sophomore Favsal Shafaat is also garnering attention, earning a spot on the preseason All-So-Con second team as a tight end.


Chattanooga opens the season with a Sept. 1 trip to Tampa, Fla., to face South Florida, a member of the Big East conference. The Mocs stay on the road in week two, traveling to Jacksonville State on Sept. 8. The home-opener is set for Thursday, Sept. 13 when UTC hosts Glenville State at 7:00 p.m. to close out non-conference action.

The Mocs host Appalachian State, Samford, Georgia Southern and Elon in SoCon action. UTC is on the road against Western Carolina, The Citadel, Furman and Wofford in league play.

#### **OUARTERBACK**

After knowing exactly who was going to be the starting quarterback going into each of the last three seasons, the Mocs will have some competition among the signal callers heading into 2012. With B.J. Coleman now competing for a spot on the Green Bay Packers' roster after being selected in April's NFL Draft, the Mocs are searching for his replacement.

No. 1 on the depth chart is 2012 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year Terrell Robinson (6-3, 195). Robinson came off the bench against for an injured Coleman at No. 1 Georgia Southern and almost led UTC to a huge upset. He finished the season with 11 total touchdowns, including six passing and five rushing, and was the only Moc with 100 rushing yards in a game last season.

Robinson played in eight games in 2011, but the first three were as a receiver, skewing his pergame numbers. He finished the year 27-43 passing for 336 yards. He ran the ball 90 times for 417 total yards.

Robinson will be pushed by freshman Jacob Huesman (6-1, 210). The son of head coach Russ Huesman, Jacob spent last season running the scout team as a redshirt. Both competed for the job in the spring and both are expected to see time on the field.

Don't count out junior Graham Nichols (6-3, 195). A more traditional passer, Nichols was inserted into the starting lineup at Samford when both Robinson and Coleman were hurt. He led UTC to a 24-9 win over the Bulldogs. Tennessee sophomore transfer Tyler Page (6-3, 195) will also compete for time at the quarterback position.



#### BACKFIELD

The Mocs played running back by committee for each of the last two years and that will again be the case in 2012. Senior Chris Awuah (5-9, 200) is the returning starter, but he will share time with a number of ball carriers this season.

Awuah is the most versatile among the group, having scored at least once in his career by rushing, receiving, passing and on special teams. Last season he ran for 227 yards and three scores while catching nine passes for 121 yards.

Fellow senior and team captain J.J. Jackson (5-9, 200) will also be in the mix. Jackson was third on the team in rushing with 234 yards and three scores on 70 carries.

Sophomore Marquis Green (5-7, 175) led the team in rushing with 530 yards on 120 carries and made the SoCon All-Freshman team. It is the second most yards by a freshman in school history. He also had three rushing TDs on the year.

Working his way back on the field is sophomore Keon Williams (6-0, 225). A member of the 2010 SoCon All-Freshman team, Williams did not practice with the team in 2011. He is looking to get back to the form that had 500 yards and four TDs on 103 carries in 2010.

Also battling for playing time at running back are freshmen Kendrix Huitt (5-9, 195) and Tolerance Shepherd (5-10, 180).

Sophomore Taharin Tyson (5-11, 225) returns after making the SoCon All-Freshman team last seaosn. He posted 143 yards and two TDs on 47 carries last year. Junior Ethan Poe (5-8, 200) will also compete for time at fullback for the Mocs.



#### OFFENSIVE LINE

After being young on the offensive line in 2011, the Mocs will welcome back an experienced group for 2012. UTC returns four of five starters, but just one senior to the line.

Senior right tackle and team captain Adam Miller (6-4, 275) leads the returners and is a preseason All-SoCon second team pick. He has started 29 of 33 games in his career, including each of the last 18.


Other starters returning include junior Kevin Revis (6-2, 275) and sophomore Patrick Sutton (6-1, 265) and Brandon Morgan (6-2, 290). Sutton started every game at center while Morgan and Revis made 10 starts at right guard and left tackle, respectively.

Sophomore Devin Caldwell (6-5, 266) and freshman Casey Hybarger (6-4, 290) are competing at right tackle behind Miller. Junior Michael Slowey (6-5, 335) has moved over from the defensive line and is joined by classmate Irvin Hernandez (5-11, 275) in the battle for time at right guard. Sophomore Shaun Hill (6-2, 265) is currently backing up Sutton at center and could work his way onto the field.

Senior Dustin Tate (6-5, 280) returns at left guard after not participating with the team in the fall. He has made four starts in 20 games in his career. Freshman Synjen Herren (6-4, 310) and junior Steven Nease (6-1, 270) also competing at left guard.

Sophomore Taylor Dodds (6-6, 275) started the first five games of the season before being sidelined with a knee-injury. He will compete with Morgan and junior Hunter Dockery (6-4, 305) at left tackle.

True freshman Robert Hill (6-2, 280) and Corey Levin could also see time at various positions in the fall (6-5, 250).



#### RECEIVER

The Mocs will have to replace two-time All-Southern Conference receiver Joel Bradford, but have a strong core of returners to fill his role. Junior Marlon Anthony leads all returners after posting 333 receiving yards and four touchdowns on 27 receptions last season. At 6-5 and 220 pounds, Anthony is a big target for the Mocs quarterbacks and needs to have a breakout season to help make up for the loss of Bradford.

Senior Jarrett Burns (6-2, 200) is also back for his third year at UTC. The former South Carolina transfer has played most of his career on special teams, but could work his way into the regular lineup this fall.

The Mocs also have a pair of talented sophomores who saw action as true freshmen last season. Tommy Hudson (5-10, 165) played in 10 games and had five catches for 30 yards. Ron Moore (6-0, 165) played in the last six games of the year, making the most out of his three receptions. He scored twice and put up 147 yards on his three catches.

Fellow sophomore Bryant Belew (6-3, 195) is also expected to contribute after playing in three games as a redshirt freshman in 2011. Sophomore Michael Trundle (6-2, 200) and redshirt freshman Taylor Stanford (6-1, 190) also return for their second season.

UTC also welcomes three talented freshmen into the mix. C.J. Board, Al Thompson and Trey James are all talented enough to work their way onto the field in 2012.

Board (6-2, 175) was a member of the Tennessean Dream Team following his senior season at West Creek High School in Clarksville, Tenn. He was also an all-state receiver.

At 6-4, 185, James is another big receiver from Banneker High School in College Park, Ga. He went under the recruiting radar after suffering an injury his senior year, but is expected to compete for the Mocs.

Thompson (6-2, 185) was a three-star recruit and a two-time all-state receiver from Brentwood (Tenn.) Academy who originally committed to Arizona State.



#### TIGHT END

The Mocs have a strong group of tight ends, led by preseason second team All-Southern Conference sophomore Faysal Shafaat (6-5, 240). Shafaat is second among the returners with 179 receiving yards and two scores on 19 catches. He made the SoCon All-Freshman team last season.

Also battling for playing time are senior Sean Stackhouse (6-4, 250), redshirt freshmen Troy Dye (6-3, 245) and Jarrod Coleman (6-4, 240) and true freshman Kevin Niethammer (6-3, 215).

Stackhouse played in all 11 games last season. He did not make a catch with most of his action coming on special teams.

## DEFENSIVE LINE

The Mocs will have a lot of talent competing for playing time on the defensive line. UTC returns four starters, including preseason All-American Josh Williams, and some big bodies joining the team.

Williams (6-2, 235) is the Mocs' all-time leader with 21.5 sacks and looks to add to that number in 2012. He will hold down the left end while preseason All-Southern Conference selection sophomore Davis Tull (6-3, 230) has the spot on the right side. Together, they combined for 14.5 sacks last season.

Backing up Williams is sophomore Zach Rayl (6-3, 230) and freshman Keionta Davis (6-4, 230). Pushing Tull for playing time will be sophomore Devin Scates (6-2, 260) and freshman Vantrell McMillan (6-2, 220).

The Mocs have three very experienced players returning in the middle in sophomores Keyon Reed (6-1, 260), Toyvian Brand (6-2, 260) and Josh Freeman (6-0, 285). Brand and Freeman both played as true freshmen while Reed led the trio with 2.5 sacks.

Chattanooga also adds two big transfers in sophomore Chris Mayes (6-3, 295) and junior Derrick Lott (6-4, 303). Mayes sat out last season after transferring from Navy while Lott transferred from Georgia during the summer. Freshman Will Mix (6-2, 220) will also compete on the line.



#### LINEBACKER


2011 All-American Wes Dothard (6-1, 225) is back for his junior year and will lead the linebacking corps. Dothard is on the Buck Buchanan Watch List as one of the top defensive players in the nation.

Dothard and fellow junior Gunner Miller (6-1, 225) were both starters in 2011. The big hole to fill here is the loss of Ryan Consiglio, who was a first team All-Southern Conference pick and led the league with 120 tackles.

Senior captain Shane Heatherly (6-4, 220) is ready to step into that spot. He was a starter as a sophomore in 2010, but lost his spot to Dothard after suffering an injury in preseason camp. His experience should give the Mocs a strong group at linebacker.

Sophomores Muhasibi Wakeel (5-11, 220) and Andrew Glaize (6-2, 210) will back up Heatherly while freshmen A.J. Hampton (6-1, 240) and Alex Kirby (6-0, 210) will compete behind Dothard. Junior C.J. Murrell (6-0, 195) and sophomore Kris Harris (6-0, 215) are listed behind Miller.

Wakeel and Murrell are the most experienced among the backup, playing in 11 and nine games, repsectively, last season.



#### SECONDARY

Chattanooga will again have a very strong secondary, thanks in large part to the return of two All-Southern Conference junior defensive backs D.J. Key (6-0, 195) and Kadeem Wise (5-10, 180). Both are preseason All-SoCon picks, with Key on the first team and Wise making the second squad.

Key was third on the team last season with 77 tackles. He also led the Mocs with three interceptions, including a school-record 85-yard pick-six against Western Carolina. Wise leads all current Mocs with eight career interceptions.

Fellow junior Chaz Moore (5-10, 165) will move into the starting roll at right cornerback after playing a lot of snaps off the bench his first two years. Also returning are junior Don Cope (5-11, 185) and sophomores Keith Mayes (5-10) and Zach McCarter (6-3, 200). Together, this group was No. 2 in the nation in pass defense last year, allowing just 141 yards in the air per game.

Junior Dean Haynes (5-11, 200) will look to break into the lineup after transferring from N.C. State. Freshman Sema'je Kendall (6-0, 175) is also back after redshirting last season.

Other newcomers include freshmen Will Johnson (5-11, 185) and Dee Virgin (5-10, 180) on the corners and Cedric Nettles (6-0, 180), William BeAird (5-11, 195) and Nakevion Leslie (5-11, 205) at safety.



UTC led the SoCon in total defense (305.3), scoring defense (19.7) and was No. 2 in the nation in pass defense (140.8) and pass efficiency defense (100.15) last season.






#### *LONG SNAPPER/HOLDER*

Chattanooga does not have an experienced long snapper on the roster, but does have a pair of freshmen competing for the job. Freshman Will Sharpton (6-3, 255) joins the team from Tullahoma High School in Tullahoma, Tenn., while fellow freshman Bryn Oliver (6-0, 210) practiced with the team in the spring after redshirting in 2011.

Sharpton was a team captain for the Wildcats and led Tullahoma to an 8-3 record last season. Oliver is the younger brother of the Mocs' four-year starting long-snapper Brock Oliver (2008-11).

The holding duties are likely to go to freshman Jacob Huesman (6-1, 210). He worked with the first team during spring practice. Sophomore Tommy Hudson (5-10, 165) also practiced the holding duties during spring workouts.



#### RETURNER

The Mocs will have to replace their primary punt returner after Joel Bradford had the job for the previous two seasons. Sophomore Tommy Hudson (5-10, 165) could have the inside track on landing the job when the season starts.

Junior Chaz Moore (5-10, 165) looks to be the top kick returner. He was No. 18 in the nation last season with a 26.0 kickoff return average. He totaled 468 vards on 18 returns with a long run of 44 yards against The Citadel.

Senior Chris Awuah (5-9, 200) had seven returns for 151 yards last season while sophomore Marguis Green (5-7, 175) had 18 yards on two returns.
