## 2011 SEASON REVIEW

### 12 POINTS, FIVE LOSSES

Chattanooga is just four plays away from being 9-2 overall and tied for the SoCon regular season title. However, the reality is the Mocs finished the season 5-6 and 3-5 in the conference thanks to four losses by a total of five points and five losses by 12 points. UTC was up 6-0 late in the third quarter and about to kick a field goal at No. 3 Appalachian State when a bad snap resulted in a Mountaineer touchdown and an eventual 14-12 loss. The Mocs then coughed up a 27-0 lead against The Citadel. A blocked punt resulted in an eventual 28-27 loss to the Bulldogs. Chattanooga followed that with a 28-27 loss at No. 1 Georgia Southern after failing to complete a two-point conversion with less than two minutes remaining. The Mocs also led Furman 7-6 with four minutes left in the game before falling 14-7. Chattanooga led 27-14 in the fourth quarter against No. 12 Wofford before dropping that game 28-27.

### 11 SENIORS END THEIR CAREERS

A total of 11 Chattanooga seniors ended their careers this season, including Sloan Allison, Joel Bradford, B.J. Coleman, Ryan Consiglio, Nick Davison, Thomas Green, Mike Hammons, De'Markus Lee, Chris Lewis-Harris, Brock Oliver and Jordan Tippit. A pair of fourth-year juniors who are on track to graduate this academic year also called it a career, including Will Hewitt and Robert Harrison. This class had 18 career wins, the most by one group since the 2001 seniors also had 18 wins in their four years.

### MOCS DEFENSE HAS BEEN IMPRESSIVE

Despite playing one of the toughest schedules in the nation, including a trip to Nebraska, the Mocs defense had some impressive numbers. These included games against three top-10 teams in No. 10 Jacksonville State, No. 3 Appalachian State and No. 1 Georgia Southern and a visit from No. 12 Wofford.

 No. 1 in the SoCon and No. 17 in the nation in scoring defense - 19.7 ppg

Chattanooga's defense did not allow an offensive touchdown at No. 3 Appalachian State. It held Georgia Southern's No. 1 ranked attack to a season-low in points, total offense and rushing offense. The Mocs also kept Elon's All-American receiver Aaron Mellette from scoring a TD for the first time this season. Chattanooga has held opponents to 14 points or less five times in 2011. It is the first time UTC has accomplished that feat since 1998.

### SEVEN MOCS NAMED ALL-SOCON BY LEAGUE COACHES

Chattanooga had seven members earn All-Southern Conference honors according to the league coaches. The Mocs put three on the first team and four on the second squad. Joel Bradford was the only other offensive player chosen from Chattanooga, making the second team. He makes his second appearance after earning first-team honors last season. He finished the year with a team-high 660 yards on 53 catches and five touchdowns. Linebackers Wes Dothard and Ryan Consiglio were joined on the first team defense by defensive end Josh Williams. Three defensive backs made the second team, including Chris Lewis-Harris, D.J. Key and Kadeem Wise.

### SEVEN MOCS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-SOCON

Chattanooga had seven members earn Academic All-Southern Conference honors in 2011. To be eligible, student-athletes must carry at least a 3.3

cumulative grade point average entering the fall season and were required to compete in at least one-half of their team's competitions during the recently-concluded fall campaign. In addition, the student-athletes must have successfully completed at least 24 credit hours in the previous two semesters. Adam Miller (3.74 - Construction Management), Brock Oliver (3.54 - Accounting), Nick Pollard (3.50 - Undecided), C.J. Murrell (3.48 - Civil Engineering), Joel Bradford (3.46 - Finance), Mike Hammons (3.44 - History) and Taylor Dodds (3.38 - Undecided) all made the team.

### FIRST QUARTER STINGY

Chattanooga's defense did not allow a point in the first quarter in seven of the last eight games of the season. UTC did not allow a touchdown in the first half in seven games in 2011.

### CHATTANOOGA WAS ONE OF THE LEAST PENALIZED TEAMS IN THE NATION

UTC finished second in the SoCon and No. 2 in the nation in fewest yards penalized per game at 33.4. The Citadel led the country in that category at 24.2 yards per game. Chattanooga went seven quarters - fourth at Elon, all of the Furman game and the first half at Samford - without being flagged for a penalty.

### MOCS LEAD SOCON IN PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Chattanooga set a school-record with 11 Southern Conference Players of the Week in 2011. With Georgia Southern grabbing nine individual awards, the Mocs led the league in weekly honors. Sophomore LB Wes Dothard and freshman QB Terrell Robinson both had three honors each. Dothard earned three defensive while Robinson grabbed three freshman honors. Senior WR/P Joel Bradford snagged offensive and special teams honors while senior LB Ryan Consiglio, junior DL Joshua Williams (defensive) and freshman RB Marquis Green (freshman) were also honored in 2011.

### MOCS WIN WHEN THEY CAN RUN THE BALL

Even though UTC is known for its passing attack, the Mocs are tough to beat when they run the ball effectively. In the three years under head coach Russ Huesman, UTC is 12-2 when outrushing its opponent, including a 4-1 mark in 2010 and 5-1 in 2011.

### ALL THREE STARTING LINEBACKERS SCORED

With sophomore Gunner Miller's 24-yard pick-6 at Elon, all three of UTC's starting linebackers scored a defensive TD this season. Senior Ryan Consiglio scooped up a fumble and ran it back 45 yards for a score against Western Carolina. Sophomore Wes Dothard scored twice, including a 30-yard pick-6 against No. 10 Jacksonville State and a 43-yard fumble return at Samford. Add in sophomore DB D.J. Key's school-record 85-yard INT return for a TD against Western Carolina and the Mocs posted a total of five defensive scores in 2011.

### WILLIAMS LEADS THE SOCON AND TOPS UTC CAREER SACK MARK

Junior DL Josh Williams earned First Team All-Southern Conference accolades after totaling a league-high 9.5 sacks this season. He became Chattanooga's all-time sack leader in 2011 and has 21.5 in his career.

### DOTHARD NAMED FIRST TEAM ALL-AMERICAN

Sophomore LB Wes Dothard was named to the 2011 The Sports Network/Fathead.com FCS All-American First Team. A native of Carrollton, Ga., he is the 44th All-American in school history and the fourth in the last three seasons under head coach Russ Huesman. He was one of just four freshmen or sophomores to make the first team. He is also the first Chattanooga sophomore to garner All-American accolades since Pumpu Tudors (P) in 1989 and the first Moc since Matt Vick in 2000 to be named First Team All-American.

UTC led the Southern Conference in total defense (305.3), pass efficiency defense (100.15), scoring defense (19.7), turnover margin (+9) and pass defense (140.8) this season. The SoCon coaches gave Dothard first team all-league honors while the media put him on the second team. A three-time SoCon Player of the Week, Dothard was also the SoCon Defensive Player of the Month for September. He had two scores, a 30-yard pick-six against No. 10 Jacksonville State and a 43-yard fumble return at Samford. He was also fourth in the nation with five forced fumbles and second on the team with 98 tackles. Dothard joins Joel Bradford (AP 3rd Team), Josh Beard (AP 3rd Team) and Craig Camay (AP 2nd Team) as All-Americans in the Huesman era.

**ROBINSON NAMED SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR**

Quarterback Terrell Robinson (South Pittsburg, Tenn.) grabbed three-straight Southern Conference Freshman of the Week honors on his way to being named SoCon Freshman of the Year in 2011. Robinson, a native of South Pittsburg, Tenn., completed 27 of 43 passes for 336 yards and six touchdowns. A dual threat for UTC, Robinson also carried 90 times for 417 yards and 5 TDs. He is the second-straight Moc, and third overall, to earn league Freshman of the Year honors, joining Kadeem Wise last season and James Roberts in 1989.

**ROBINSON, SIX OTHERS EARN SOCON ALL-FRESHMAN HONORS**

Seven Mocs made the Southern Conference All-Freshman team led by Freshman of the Year Terrell Robinson. Seven on the All-Freshman squad beats the Mocs' previous high of five set last season. Robinson was joined on the offensive side by running back Marquis Green (Palmetto, Fla.) and tight end Faysal Shafaat (Orlando, Fla.). Green finished with a team-best 530 yards rushing, the second-highest total by a freshman in school history. Shafaat caught 19 passes for 179 yards and two touchdowns.

**BACK-TO-BACK 40+ POINTS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN MANY YEARS**

UTC lit up the scoreboard for 51 points against Western Carolina and 42 points at Elon. It is the first time in the Division I era (since 1977) that Chattanooga scored 40+ points in consecutive games. The last time it happened in consecutive games was the final game of Scrappy Moore's career - a 51-0 win over Jacksonville State on Nov. 18, 1967 - and the first game of Harold Wilkes career - a 41-13 win over Austin Peay on the season-opener in 1968. The last time it happened in the regular season was the first three games in 1922.

**MOCs IN THE RANKINGS**

UTC received votes in the final Sports Network/Fathead.com FCS Top 25, one of the two polls recognized by the NCAA. Chattanooga had been ranked for a school-record sixth-straight weeks early in the season. It was the most consecutive weeks ranked to start a season and the most weeks ranked in one year in school history. The Mocs climbed as high as No. 13 in the nation following a 23-14 win at Eastern Kentucky on Sept. 17.

**BRADFORD WRAPS UP STELLAR CAREER**

Senior WR Joel Bradford garnered countless preseason All-American honors heading into 2011. He did not put up the same numbers as he did during his junior season that earned him All-American honors, but he did make the All-Southern Conference second team. Last season, he broke the Mocs' school record with 1,284 receiving yards and was named 3rd Team All-American by the Associated Press.

He finished the year with 53 catches for 660 yards and five touchdowns. He was fourth in the SoCon with 4.8 receptions per game and fifth in the league with 60.0 receiving yards per game.

After making four catches for 47 yards at Nebraska, Bradford had a breakout game against No. 10 Jacksonville State. He tied a career-high with 15 catches for 162 yards. He earned SoCon Offensive Player of the Week honors for the third time in his career. That game tied for the fourth-most catches in a game by an FCS player this season.

Bradford was also stellar in the classroom, posting a 4.0 g.p.a. in the fall and earning Academic All-SoCon honors for the third year and FCS ADA Academic All-Star team recognition for the second season. He graduated with a degree in Finance in the fall.

**COLEMAN DRAFTED BY THE GREEN BAY PACKERS**

B.J. Coleman became the 47th Moc to be drafted in the NFL when the Green Bay Packers took him in the seventh round. He was chosen with the 243 overall pick and is the second player chosen in the last two years. Buster Skrine was taken in the fifth round by Cleveland in 2011.

Despite only playing in 29 games in his three year career, Coleman made a tremendous impact on the Mocs since transferring from Tennessee in 2009. He is second all-time at UTC with 6,871 career passing yards and is just the fourth Moc to throw for 6,000 yards. He set a UTC record with 52 career TD passes and is one of just two Mocs in school history with six+ 300-yard passing games.

**BRADFORD, MILLER NAMED TO FCS ADA ACADEMIC ALL-STAR TEAM**

Senior Joel Bradford and junior Adam Miller represented UTC on the 14th annual Football Championship Subdivision Athletics Directors Association Academic All-Star Team announced by the Football Championship Subdivision Athletics Directors Association (FCS ADA). It was the first selection for Miller and the second for Bradford. The Mocs have had at least one on the team in each of the last three seasons, including Steven Smigelsky in 2009.

Football players from all Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) institutions were eligible for these prestigious awards. Each of the nominees were required to have a minimum grade point average of 3.20 (on a 4.00 scale) in undergraduate study and have been a starter or key player with legitimate athletics credentials. He must have reached his second year of athletics and academic standing at the nominated institution and have completed a minimum of one full academic year at the nominated institution. He must also have participated in 50 percent of the games played at his designated position.

Bradford graduated in December with a degree in Finance and carried a 3.46 grade-point-average. Miller has a 3.74 g.p.a. as a Construction Management major.

**THIRD YEAR IN A ROW MOCs BREAK SEASON TICKET SALES MARK**

Chattanooga broke its season ticket sales record in each of head coach Russ Huesman's first three years. In 2009, the Mocs sold 2,527 season tickets, topping that with 2,676 last year. UTC sold 2,761 for the 2011 season.

**ATTENDANCE IN THE HUESMAN ERA**

UTC has seen a dramatic growth in attendance at home football games since the hiring of Russ Huesman in December 2008. Seven of the Mocs' top 10 crowds in school history have come in the 15 home games of the Huesman era. Chattanooga is averaging 11,212 fans per game since the start of 2009. Prior to Huesman's arrival, UTC averaged 5,767 fans per game in the 2008 season.
